Palm Sunday recalls the story in Christian Scripture of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, greeted by people waving palm branches. It is a **reminder for Christians to welcome Jesus into their hearts and to be willing to follow him.** Jesus Christ **rode on a donkey into Jerusalem**, and the celebrating people there laid down their cloaks and small branches of trees in front of him, singing part of Psalm 118: 25-26 – Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord.
