THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD

The "Passion" may include, among other events, Jesus's triumphal entry into Jerusalem, his cleansing of the Temple, his anointing, the Last Supper, his agony, his arrest, his trials before the Sanhedrin and before Pilate, his crucifixion and death, and his burial. On a basic level, the English word "passion" is **derived from the Latin word passio, meaning suffering.** The expression thus came to describe the afflictions Christ endured for our sins on the last day of his life.
